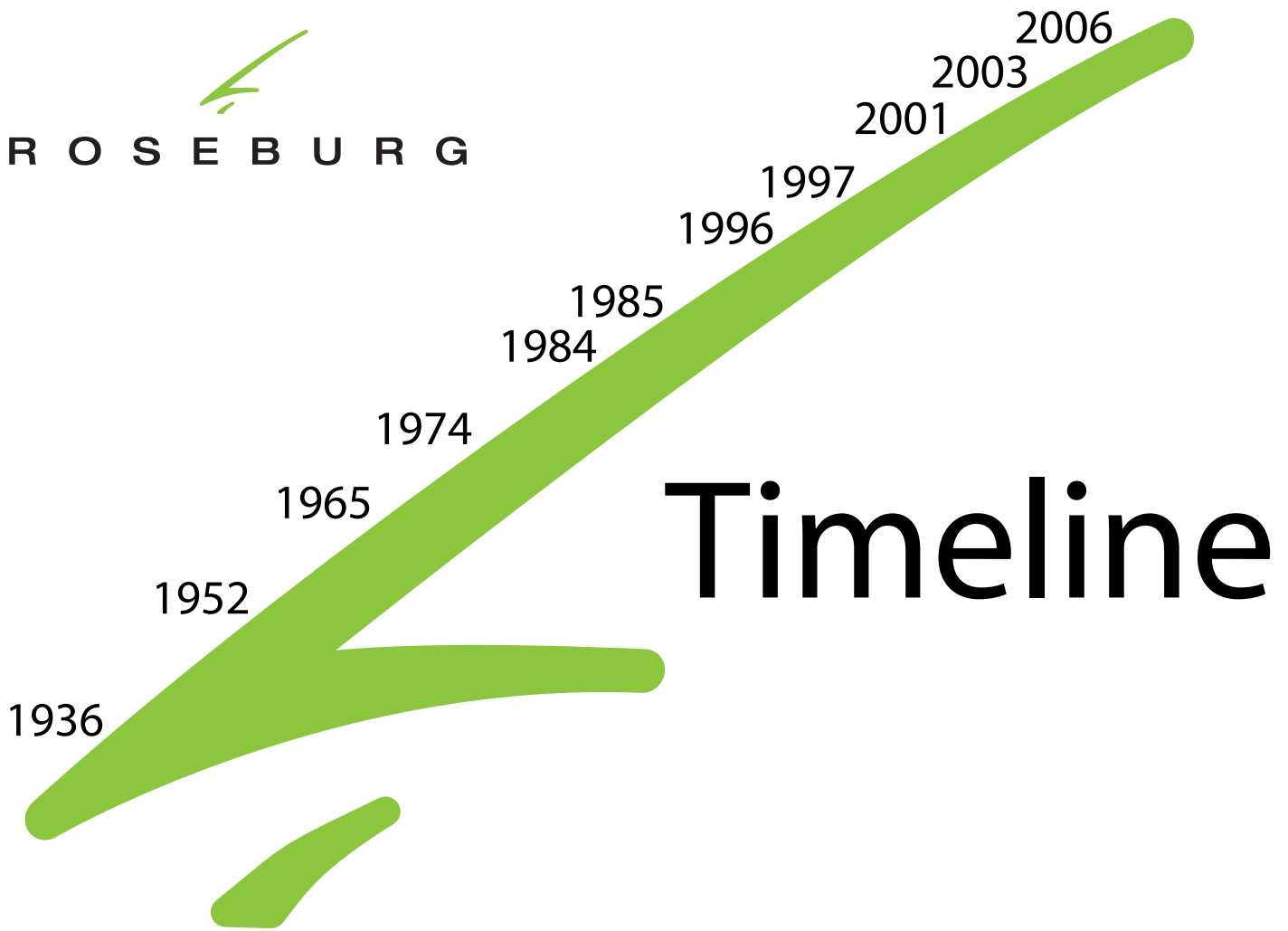

1936 - Roseburg Lumber Co. is created by owner Kenneth Ford.

1952 - Softwood plywood production begins.

1965 - Largest Particleboard plant in North America is built in Dillard, Oregon.

1974 - World's largest wood chip export terminal built in North Bend, Oregon.

1984 - First thermally-fused melamine press is installed in Dillard, Oregon.

1985 - Roseburg Lumber Company becomes Roseburg Forest Products.

1996 - Roseburg purchases International Paper's timberlands in Southwest Oregon, increasing total timberlands holdings to 750,000.

1997 - Allyn Ford becomes President & CEO.

2001 - One of North America's largest Engineered wood products plant is built in Riddle, Oregon.

2003 - Roseburg purchases Louisiana-Pacific particleboard plant in Missoula, Montana.

2006 - Seven composite panel plants in the Southeast purchased from Georgia-Pacific.
